





Memorandum of Understanding Between

## UNIVERSITY OF GRANADA GRANADA, SPAIN And

## THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS AMHERST AMHERST, USA

The University of Granada and the University of Massachusetts Amherst have shown their interest to enter into a cooperative academic relationship which is outlined by the following inter-institutional memorandum on academic and research collaboration.

Both universities have agreed to discuss cooperation in joint educational programs and research projects. Under this Memorandum, both universities will encourage direct contacts and cooperation between their faculty members, graduate students, departments, institutes, and academic planning staff. As per interest shown, both universities have agreed to explore the possibility of:

- Establishing mutually beneficial collaborative research projects between departments and individual faculty members.
- 2. Exchange of faculty members for short- and long-term visits for the purpose of research, teaching, and the presentation of seminars.
- 3. Exchange of graduate students.
- 4. Joint supervision of doctoral research students between interested faculty members on both sides.
- 5. Other activities of mutual interest and benefit,

Arrangements for specific visits and other forms of academic cooperation will be developed jointly and will be agreed upon for each specific case. The exchange of students will require a supplementary agreement, specifying the terms of exchange.







Both universities understand that all of the above arrangements involve financial considerations and have agreed that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated separately.

This memorandum will remain in effect for five (5) years at the end of which period the memorandum will be reviewed by both parties and may be renewed by mutual written consent. This memorandum may be terminated by either party by a six-months' written notification of termination by either party.
