HOW TO GET TO HOTELS

(those located close to Gran Vía – Plaza Nueva)

BY CAR:

Plaza Nueva square, *Gran Vía*, *Reyes Católicos* and *Recogidas* have partially or completely restricted traffic for most of the day (see the attached map).

However, you will be able to arrive by car at the hotel and download your luggage for 10-15 minutes. It is recommended that you take *Elvira* street or **San Matias** street. Please, contact with your Hotel for more precise information.

We recommend you leave the car in one of two nearby car parks:

- **1- Parking San Agustin:** it is behind *Gran Vía*, before getting to the Cathedral and close to San Agustin Market (25 euros/24 hours).
- **2- Parking Puerta Real:** is close to El Corte Inglés (in the city centre) and just at the *Fuente de las Batallas* (20 euros/ 24 hours).

> BY BUS:

There are many daily buses between Granada and other Spanish cities. The largest bus company is ALSA. You can purchase online at: http://www.alsa.es/portal/site/Alsa.

You can also check times and prices and even choose your seat. The bus station is in the North of Granada. At the exit of the bus station you can find city bus stops and taxis.

Taking a city bus

City buses pass with a frequency of about 10 to 15 min. The fare is 1.20 €, but the best thing is to buy a bus pass (there are different price options), more information at: http://www.granadadirect.com/transporte/bonobus-granada/.

Once at the bus station, take line 33 or line 3, both coaches made the following route; Ctra de Jaén, Avenida de Madrid, Dr. Olóriz, Avenida de la Constitución, and Gran Via (there are

Taking a taxi from the bus station:

To take a taxi from the bus station you should go to the taxi stand, located at the exit of the station or call 958 280654

Once inside the taxi it is only necessary to indicate the hotel. The price ranges between 8-10 €

> BY TRAIN:

The train station is very centrally located on Avenida Andaluces. The telephone number is 958 27 12 72. You can check the website of RENFE (http://www.renfe.es/) where there is detailed information about schedules and fares.

Taking a city bus

City buses pass approximately every 10 -15 min. The fare is 1.20 €, but the best thing is to buy a bus pass, more information at http://www.granadadirect.com/transporte/bonobus-granada/.

To take the bus you have to leave the train station and go up the Avenida Andaluces, and reach a broad avenue called Avenida de la Constitución. There you turn right and find the stop No. 3 at Constitution Avenue. Here you can take city buses No. 1, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, all of them go through the Avenida de Constitución to **Gran Vía.**

Taking a taxi:

To take a taxi from the train station you should go to the taxi stand, located just outside the station, or call to 958 280654.

Once inside the taxi it is only necessary to indicate the hotel. The price can range from 6-8 €.

BY PLANE (Granada airport):

Taking a bus from the airport to Granada:

Granada airport is located 10 km from the city. After each flight, there is a bus for passengers between the airport and the city center (various stops). The bus costs 3 €More information at Granada Airport Buses: http://www.granadadirect.com/transporte/aeropuerto-granada/.

Taking a taxi from the airport to Granada

To take a taxi from the airport you just have to go to the taxi stop located outside the airport or call 958 28 06 54.

It would be better to ask how much the trip will cost before getting into the taxi in order not to get surprised, especially if you are a foreigner. On these trips the taximeter is not used, since the airport is outside the city limits, and it has a fixed price depending on the area you are going to. There is an official list of prices you can ask the taxi driver for. The price is about 25 euros.

Once inside the taxi it is only necessary to indicate the direction of the hotel.



HOW TO GET TO "CARMEN DE LA VICTORIA"

El Carmen de la Victoria is located in an historic neighborhood of Granada (Albayzín), an area considered World Heritage by UNESCO. Traffic is restricted to residents almost all the day and it is not possible to get to the Congress venue by car (see map). Taxis are allowed access, so it is always possible to use these.

From Plaza Nueva a very attractive way to go is by foot, following the river **Darro** to **Cuesta de Chapíz.** It takes 15-20 minutes.

There is also the bus to go to **EL Carmen de la Victoria**. Bus No. 31 (called "Alhambra Bus") stops at the Peso de la Harina (in the **Cuesta del Chapíz**). Carmen de la Victoria is located in front of the bus stop. These buses (which are smaller than usual) go through **Gran Vía** street, Reyes Católicos, **Plaza Nueva**, Carrera del Darro, Paseo de los Tristes and **Cuesta de Chapíz**. In this last street, get off at *Peso de la Harina* (see diagram below).

HOW TO GET TO "HOSPITAL REAL"


Hospital Real is the rector's office of the University of Granada

The first day of the congress, at the end of the afternoon, a reception will take place in the Hospital Real (see map)

It is possible to walk along **Gran Vía** or Elvira street, it takes between 30-45 minutes from the centre.

From the Carmen de la Victoria you can also take the bus "Alhambra Bus" No 31 at the stop *Peso de la Harina*, since it has a circular route. You should get off at the stop called *Professor Emilio Orozco* (see diagram below). In this case, you have to walk about 5 minutes to the Hospital Real (see map).

You also can take the "Alhambra Bus" No 31 from any other stop near to your Hotel.
