DIRECT STRATEGIES: LISTENING

STRATEGY GROUP: Memory

STRATEGY SET: Reviewing well

STRATEGY: Structured reviewing

This strategy is especially useful for remembering new material in the target language. It entails reviewing at different intervals, at first close together and then increasingly far apart.

E.g.: Misha is learning a set of vocabulary words in English. He practices them immediately, waits 15 minutes before practicing them again, and practices them an hour later, three hours later, the next day, two days later, four days later, the following week, two weeks later, and so on until the material becomes more or less automatic.
