STRATEGY SET: Applying images and sounds

Strategy: Using imagery

A good way to remember what has been heard in the new language is to create a mental image of it.

E.g.: Adel, a Spanish bank manager learning English, tries to remember the American phrase <i>tax shelter</i> , which he has just heard. He uses a mental image of a small house protecting or sheltering a pile of money inside.
