**STRATEGY SET:** Applying images and sounds

**STRATEGY:** Representing sounds in memory

This strategy involves linking the new word with familiar words or sounds from any language: the new language, one's own language, or any other. Rhymes are a well-known example of representing sounds in memory, but they are not the only way to represent sounds mentally.
