

STRUCTURE OF A MONOGRAPH

- 1. *Title*:
- 2. Introduction:
 - a. ¿Why have I chose this topic?
 - b. ¿What is its social significance?
 - c. ¿What is the relation of this topic with the teaching?
- 3. Development:
 - a. Exposition of ideas into paragraphs, paragraphs and chapters.
 - b. At the end of the exposure of each idea, enter the following.
 - c. At the beginning of each new ideas expressed (paragraph or section) the relationship of the above.
 - d. Quote authors endorse these ideas
- 4. Conclusion:
 - a. Synthesis of all the ideas highlighting the personal contributions.
