Presentations types:

- Keynotes, about 30 minutes followed by 10 minutes discussion
- Oral presentations, 20 minutes followed by 5 minutes discussion
- Poster presentations, three open sessions two hours long each. During the presentation of posters, beer, wine and soft drinks with tapas will be available.

- Abstract submission: April 1 to July 15.
- A book of abstracts will be published

Social activities for accompanying persons:

- In addition to the social activities for delegates (see schedule) and while the workshop sessions are taking place, a social program for accompanying persons will be organized. Activities will include visits to the most interesting and beautiful places in Granada.

Registration and Fees:

- Registration: April 1 to July 15
- Fees for attendees include all meals (except breakfast), social acts, field excursion, abstracts book and documentation.
 - **Early registration fee (April 1 to May 31): 450 €**
 - **Late registration fee (June 1 to July 15): 500 €**
- The fees for accompanying persons include the same as for attendees except coffees, beer and tapas, abstract book and documentation. The field trip to Ronda can be substituted for a visit to Malaga city and the Picasso Museum.
 - **Accompanying person fee: 400 €**

Fees will be payed by bank transfer to the [University bank account](#). We are trying to implement payment by credit card, but it is not sure we can overcome the tremendous bureaucracy involved.
